
COMMODORE'S COMMENTS

Remember, open thru-hull valves in a boat can let water in after a freeze breaks the plumbing. Even a winterized boat is at risk of sinking when left unattended for long periods of time. Wave action during a storm can syphon water into a sink or toilet and slowly swamp a boat. Good dock lines will keep our boats secure when the north wind blows and closed seacocks will keep them afloat.


CHRISTMAS PARTY FUN – SATURDAY, DECEMBER 5TH
