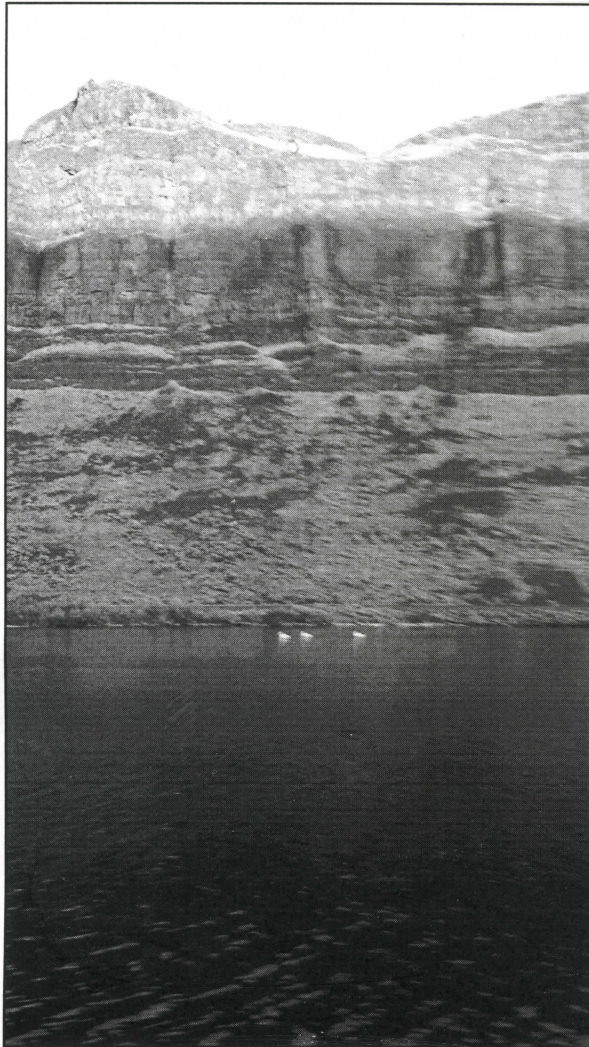


## HUSTON'S REEF
